PROJECT BACKGROUND





The relocation site is located in Brgy. Cayang, Bogo City, Cebu, and is one of the three communities of France- Philippines United Action (FPUA) Foundation.

The houses were inaugurated on December 2, 2017.

The 46 beneficiary-families have access to electricity and water and their community provide a safe haven for them to come home to from work and from school.



PROJECT BACKGROUND



Part of the site development of the village, FPUA committed to build a multipurpose center (MPC) on site for the community.

The 60 sqm multi-purpose center intends to provide a safe place and venue for the community to reunite and organize activities.

In 2018, with an initial funding from the German cooperation, FPUA initiated the construction of a Multi-Purpose Center (MPC).

Due to unexpected circumstances, the construction encountered delay and resumed in January 2019.

The MPC was fully completed in mid-February 2021 and will be inaugurated this May (date to be announced).

- a place for FPUA to continue supporting the community through activities, trainings, seminars, health missions, etc.
- an evacuation center for the neighbourhood communities in times of calamity
