What is SWITCH?

A switch is needed from unsustainable to sustainable patterns of development. The SWITCH ASIA Programme is born out of this need. The Programme focuses on sustainable consumption and production (SCP) and directly contributes to sustainable growth and the fight against poverty.

The Programme adresses both sides:

- ◆ Supply side: it promotes new methods and technologies in order to make business processes more environmentally sustainable and efficient:
- ◆ Demand side: it supports consumer's behaviour and choices in use of goods and services that are more environmentally friendly.

Who can apply?

SWITCH funding will be awarded in the form of grants to EU-Asia partnerships of non-profit making organisations. These organisations must demonstrate an ability to reach out to large numbers of SMEs or consumer groups.

We welcome proposals where intermediaries such as business associations, industry associations, retailers and Chambers of Commerce will play an active role in the partnership.

How to apply?

European Commission representatives will explain in detail the objectives of the Programme and the application procedures during the Information Session.
